Chairman Shield 2009 (Inter-Unit Foot Drill Competition)

General Rules

The Chairman Shield – the award for ‘Inter-Unit Foot Drill Competition’ (the Competition) is opened to all interested Squadrons and School Units of Hong Kong Adventure Corps.

2. Each team shall consist of one (1) Team Leader and fifteen (15) Members. All players must hold positions lower than the rank of Officer and above the rank of Recruit. At the time of registration all team representatives are required to show the *Hong Kong Adventure Corps Membership Cards* of all team members. Once registration is completed, changes to the Team Leader / Members is prohibited.

3. There are two parts in the competition :

- a. Part I – Uniform Inspection
- b. Part II – Foot Drill Performance

4. The order of the teams competing in both Parts I and II will be decided by balloting to be held at the Team Leaders’ Briefing which will be conducted one month prior to the competition date.

5. Part I of the competition will be performed at the “Uniform Inspection Area”. All teams are required to report to the Officer-in-charge five (5) minutes prior to their scheduled time. After Part I is completed the team will immediately proceed to Part II.

6. Points are awarded for the following attributes :

- a. Prim and Proper Presentation of Uniform Attire
- b. Performance of the Team
- c. Words of Command
- d. Personal Foot Drill Standard of the Team Leader (specific requirements of the Foot Drill Performance is stated in Annex C).

7. The Champion will be based on the Uniform Inspection and the performance of the Foot Drill (Part I + Part II) and the winning team will be presented with the Champion Trophy and hold the title for one year. Additional prizes will also be awarded for the following titles :

- a. The Best Team Leader Award
- b. The Best Uniform Team Award

8. Thirty (30) marks will be deducted for failure to report punctually to the Officer-in-charge at the designated areas for Part I or II of the Competition.

9. Sequence of Words of Command must be exact. Any variations of such would lead to deduction of marks.

10. In the event of a tie for any of the additional awards, the deciding factor would be the Team Leader with the higher score in the Competition.

11. In the event that there is a tie in the overall competition the deciding factor will be the team's performance in 'Getting On Parade'.

12. In the case of disputes the final decision rests with the Panel of Judges and further appeal will not be entertained.
